Drug-related incidents for 2010-11 (53) represent:

- ✓ 39% decrease from 2009-10
- ✓ 43% decrease from 2008-09
- ✓ Lowest number since 2006-07

Alcohol-related incidents for 2010-11 (23) represent:

- ✓ Highest number in OC Schools since 1996-97 (32)
- ✓ More than double the number in 2009-10 (11)

Overall, we had 76 drug- and alcohol-related incidents discovered in school or school-sponsored activities. The number represents:

- ✓ Lowest total since 2007-08 (71)
- ✓ 22% decrease from 2009-10 (98)
- ✓ 25% decrease from 2008-09 (102)

Interesting/disturbing trends:

- ✓ For **2009-10**, Prescription Drug-related incidents constituted **38%** of all drug-related incidents for that year (38/87)
- ✓ For **2010-11**, Prescription Drug-related incidents constituted **51%** of all drug-related incidents for that year (27/53)

- ✓ For **2009-10**, Marijuana-related incidents constituted **62%** of all drug-related incidents for that year (54/87)
 - ✓ For **2010-11**, Marijuana-related incidents constituted **49%** of all drug-related incidents for that year (26/53)
